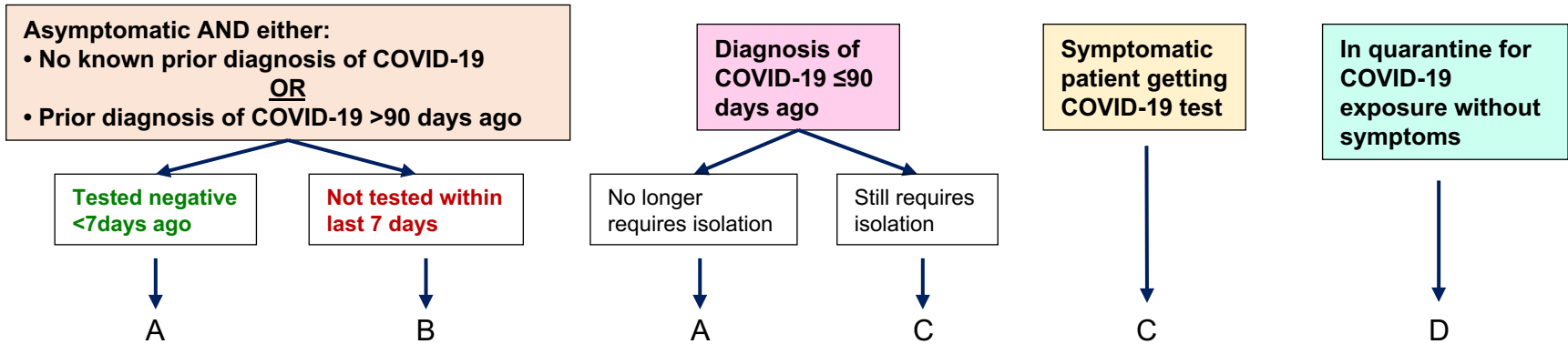


SF Health Network: Room selection, PPE, and room hold times for outpatient visits

Note: when nebulizer treatment given for symptoms, room hold can be shortened to **15 minutes** if have a negative COVID-19 test result today or up to 2 days prior during the current episode of symptoms. COVID-19 test can be a PCR or antigen test.
